

Steen Lundstroem Profile



Steen is a prominent Danish artist who works in various media e.g. Painting, graphics, collage and sculpture. His paintings are broad and expressive, often on large scale canvases. The large brushstrokes, despite their dominance, enhance the more delicate elements of his paintings such as little splash marks or fine lines. His paintings are non-figurative expressionist paintings in which he captures elements of life.



Born in Denmark in 1945 where he currently lives and works, Steen has become one of Denmark's leading artists. He trained at The Royal Danish Academy of Fine Arts in 1973.

His work has been exhibited abroad as well as in Denmark and is represented in Kobberstikssamlingen, Statens Museum for Kunst and Vejle Kunstmuseum.
