<b>10 Il Carretto IGT Bianco di Sicilia, Italy,</b>		<b>£15.25</b>
This soft, lively Sicilian white offers distinctive citrus flavours with hints of herb and almond.		
<b>11 Corney &amp; Barrow House White VdP du Gers</b>	<b>£4.75</b>	<b>£16.50</b>
A 50/50 blend of local grapes, Colombard and Ugni Blanc, this wine is fresh and zingy with white flower and lemon character.

Fresh, grassy with gooseberry fruits and a great long finish. A delicious glass of wine from one of the up and coming areas in Chile.

Hand picked at night this Pinot Grigio is the real deal that leaves the supermarkets offerings well behind. Good structure with floral notes and hints of pear and apricot.		
<b>14 Santa Florentina, Unwooded Chardonnay Fairtrade Valles del Famatina</b>		<b>£18.95</b>
Ultra fresh, Organic Chardonnay with 'Fairtrade' status to boot! Produced in Argentina's oldest winemaking province: Famatina Valley		
<b>15 Chenin Blanc, Lowrys Pass, South Africa</b>		<b>£19.95</b>
Great value, modern South African Chenin Blanc. Light, zesty and equally enjoyable with food or on its own		

**16 Terre de Lumière Viognier, Jean d'Alibert, Vin de Pays d'Oc** **£21.50**

This wine perfectly demonstrate what quality producers in this region can do. Ripe and round with creamy, peach fruit and spice, a super food wine.

**17 Fiano Masseria Bianca IGT Salento- Puglia,Italy,** **£22.50**

Cecilia Beretta is a small, family-run wine estate based near Verona. Firm streak of refreshing, wet-stone minerality, tingling acidity and a long, soft finish of ripe peach.

**18 Sauvignon Blanc, Eradus, Marlborough New Zealand** **£28.50**

This vibrant, aromatic wine comes from the Awatere Valley, south of the better-known Wairau Plains. Michiel Eradus, owner/winemaker, believes the prolonged ripening period here is key to the wines' flavour intensity. Herbaceous and mineral with a long, rich finish.

**19 Chablis Domaine Damppt** **£31.95**

The Damppt family is famous for its winemaking expertise and and young talent Vincent is the new kid on the block. We were struck by the classic elegance and approachable style of his Chablis, counterbalancing flinty minerality and soft, creamy fruit.

**20 Sancerre Domaine Grand Maison,France** **£33.95**

The vineyards of Sancerre are spread over 15 villages on very chalky stone. A tiny farm produces this; one of the finest Sancerre's to be found.

**21 Macon-Verze Domaines Leflaive** **£36.95**

Domaine Leflaive purchased this Macon property back in 2004. Conversion to biodynamic viticulture began immediately. Complex layers of stone fruit, citrus and zesty minerality.

**22 Meursault, Domaine Henri Darnat.** **£47.00**

Henri Darnat owns 5 small Meursault parcels of vines, some up to 75 years old. These old vines gives small quantities of concentrated fruit elegant stone fruit and light butterscotch notes, balanced by fresh acidity and well-integrated oak.

**32 Terre de Lumiere Pinot Noir Rose Celliers Jean d'Alibert IGP Pays d'Oc,** **£18.25**

Delicate and refreshing Pinot Noir Rosé with perfectly balanced aromas of crunchy berries and violet. A perfect companion for your summer nights!

**33 Pinot Grigio Rose, Montovento** **£17.25**

Light as feather and pink as a blush, easy drinking Pinot from the Vento region in Italy.

**Reds**

**50 Il Carretto IGT Rosso di Puglia,Italy ,** **£15.25**

This moreish, juicy Sangiovese comes from selected vineyards in Italy's warm south.

**51 Corney & Barrow House Red** **£4.75** 175ml **£16.50**

Languedoc's warm Mediterranean climate coupled with the Mistral's cooling sea breezes give this wine its characteristic fresh, ripe fruit flavours . An accessible blend of Carignan, Grenache and Merlot.

**52 Rosario Cabernet Sauvignon San Pedro,Chile,** **£5.00** 175ml **£17.50**

The quality of Chilean wines has flourished in the last twenty years, people worldwide enjoy the easy-drinking charm of Chile's fruity wines and this Cabernet is no exception.

- 53 Merlot Domaine St Esteve IGP Pays d'Oc** **£17.95**  
 The Garcia family have lived and produced wine at this property on the borders of Minervois for four generations. Their Merlot is silky and round, exuding soft plum fruit
- 54 Chamuyo Malbec, Mendoza 2008, Argentina,** **£18.50**  
 Care and passion are really evident in this wine grapes are hand picked at night from 20 year old vines. White pepper notes make this perfect with Cumberland sausage.
- 55 Puertas Antiguas, Shiraz, Maipo, Chile** **£19.25**  
 This ripe, soft-textured Shiraz bursts with black fruit, violet notes and a hint of peppery spice.
- 56 Rioja, Tempranillo, Altos de Baroja Rioja Jove, Spain** **£20.95**  
 Juicy and fruit-driven, showcasing dark cherry fruit and subtle spice. Based in Rioja Alavesa, the finest part of the region.
- 57 Viñamar Reserva Pinot Noir Maipo Valley, Chile,** **£24.25**  
 Purity and freshness are the keywords for this spicy Pinot Noir rich and complex Just the thing for are locally sourced lamb.
- 58 Chateau La Courolle - Montagne St Emillion, France, Bordeaux** **£29.95**  
 Excellent value for money, a good quality, silky and luscious offering from the satellite Montagne St Emilion.
- 59 Crozes-Hermitage Le Millepertuis Maison Guyot, France, Rhone** **£32.50**  
 This 100% Syrah is made in a contemporary, fruit-forward style: fresh and spicy, with dried herb notes and plenty of dark plum and damson fruit.
- 60 Malbec Achaval Ferrer, Mendoza Argentina** **£39.50**  
 Critically acclaimed Malbec with a 92 point score from the Wine Spectator. Juicy and packed with loads of black fruits.
- 61 Domaine de L'Aurage, Cote du Castillon, Bordeaux, France,** **£44.50**  
 True Mitjavile wine expressing the real Terroir of the appellation. Layered fruit, punctuated by dark chocolate notes and mocha cream, headily spiced.
- 62 Mercurey Les Montots Domaine A et P de Villaine 2011** **£49.00**  
 Outstanding Mercurey from one of the best producers in the region. Limpid ruby red, this has a very fresh approach, wild herbs blended with red berry fruit, cherry and pepper spice. Perfect.

## Dessert Wines

### **80 Chateau Septy Monbazillac, France 2009**

**£4.25 50ml £17.95**

A wine that gives a wealth of intense sweet fruit, rich and impressive. A fantastic alternative to a pricier Sauternes. Bright gold perfect balance of acidity and honeyed sweetness.

### **81 San Emillio Perdro Ximinez Reserva Lustau**

**£4.85 50ml**

Darker than the night and richer than something very rich, perfect poured onto ice cream. Made with Pedro Ximénez grapes, which are dried under the hot Spanish sun, concentrating the sweetness to create intense flavours of raisins and molasses. Truly amazing stuff.

## Ports

### **Corney & Barrow Ruby Port**

**£2.95 50ml**

Barao de Vilar is a family-owned, quality-driven producer of Port wines. This delicious Ruby is blended and matured in large oak barrels, giving a young, fruity character to the finished wine. This port is great to enjoy on its own or paired with cheese or dessert.

### **Corney & Barrow 10 year old Tawny Port**

**£3.95 50ml**

Cristiano Van Zeller, a pioneering Portuguese producer, has worked with C&B for many years. Rich, smoky, nutty characters blend beautifully with dried fruit and spice, all lifted by a refreshing acidity
