From London Victoria

From Victoria catch the train heading to either Uckfield or East Grinstead.

The Uckfield line will take you direct to Cowden (About 40 minutes).

If you catch the East Grinstead line you will need to change at Oxted to get on the Uckfield Line to Cowden (Sometimes there is a train waiting otherwise you will normally have to wait 20 minutes).

From London Bridge

From London Bridge catch the train to East Croydon. Change here and catch the train heading to either Uckfield or East Grinstead. (see London Victoria directions for the rest of the journey)

From Gatwick Airport

From Gatwick catch the train to Redhill. Change at Redhill to the Tonbridge Line and get off at Edenbridge station. It's best to make prior arrangements for a taxi to meet you. Alternatively, walk to the Edenbridge Town Station and catch the train to Cowden. Please note that the two Edenbridge stations are about a 20 minute walk from each other from one end of town to the other.

From Cowden station

It is possible to walk to Becketts via the road but this is not advisable.

The best way is to go via the footpath (20 minutes walk) – come out of Cowden station and turn right. Go under the bridge and immediately on the right is a stile. Go over and follow the path through the woods. Continue until you meet a track turning left, suitable for cars. Follow track up the hill until you meet the road and Becketts is on your right. PLEASE NOTE this footpath is unlit and can also be very muddy so wear sensible shoes or boots.

If you do not intend to walk and carry your cases from Cowden station to Becketts, arrange for a taxi to meet you at Edenbridge station or Edenbridge Town station.
